Through the project's capacity building, gender equality promotion, and women's empowerment activities, the Women's Network which has been active in Hanoi, Quang Tri, Da Nang, Ben Tre, Ha

Tinh, Nghe An, and Yen Bai has made significant contributions to the implementation of the National Climate Change Adaptation Plan (NAP) and the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) in Vietnam. Especially, for the first time, CECR has successfully developed a tool to evaluate women's contribution to reducing greenhouse gas emissions in the field of waste management in Vietnam; CECR also developed 18 messages to COP 25 and 26; 03 policy briefs on gender mainstreaming in water resource management, waste management and sustainable forest management.


