WATER CONSERVATION

Vietnam has a relatively rich surface water source on which Vietnamese people's life depend significantly. However, many of them are facing the deterioration of water quality due to pollution sources. In urban areas and industrial areas, water in rivers, streams, and canals is polluted and becomes hazardous to humans and aquatic life. To control water pollution requires a lot of focus, commitment, participation and joint efforts of all governments, communities, businesses and scientific organizations, scientists, to reduce damage to the aquatic environment.

To contribute to the protection, improvement and restoration of Vietnam's surface water sources, CECR has focused on activities:
